The Class of 2012:

- 22 JMU alumni started medical school in the fall of 2008 (18 in MD programs, 4 in DO programs). These students are from 5 different graduating classes (03, 05, 06, 07 and 08) and 7 different degree programs (Biology, Chemistry, Communication Sciences & Disorders, Dietetics, Health Sciences, History, and Psychology).
- JMU alumni are attending 8 allopathic medical schools (U of VA [5] VCU/MCV [5], EVMS [2], U of Maryland [1], Uniformed Services [1], George Washington U [1], St. Louis U [1], and Temple [1]) and 4 osteopathic medical schools (Edward Via VA COM, Philadelphia COM – Main campus, PCOM - Atlanta campus, and Nova Southeastern U COM).

The Class of 2013:

- 24 JMU alumni started medical school in the fall of 2009 (15 in MD programs, 9 in DO programs). The MD students are from 7 different graduating classes (03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08 and 09) and 7 different degree programs (Biology [9], Biotechnology [1], Chemistry [3], Health Sciences [2], Integrated Science & Technology [1], Modern Foreign Languages [1], and Physics [1]); 3 students completed double majors. The DO students are from 6 different graduating classes (02, 04, 06, 07, 08 and 09) and 3 different degree programs (Biology [4], Health Sciences [4], and Finance [1]).
- JMU alumni matriculated in 7 allopathic medical schools (EVMS [5], VCU/MCV [3], U of VA [2], Drexel [2], U of Maryland [1], Jefferson [1] and Meharry [1]) and 6 osteopathic medical schools (Philadelphia COM – Main campus [3], Edward Via VA COM [2], New York COM of NYIT [1], Lake Erie COM – Bradenton [1], Ohio U COM [1] and Lincoln Memorial U [1]).
